## What Users Can Do with ACquire

Feature	Benefit
Dated Directories for Report Storage	The company has immediate electronic access to archived reports; bypasses manual search and retrieval of paper reports. Enables fast response to past history requests and to audits.
"Paper-Less" Reports	Instead of printing 5 copies of that 300-page report and distributing them manually, each user can view the report online and print <i>only</i> the needed pages. Most users need only one or two pages from a report.
On-Line Research	Each user can do ad-hoc research in the ACquire report viewer. For example, list all accounts with a balance greater than \$5,000 that is over 60 days old. This frequently eliminates the need for another custom report.
Extract Desired Data	The report viewer enables each user to extract needed data directly to Excel, MS Access or other file formats for desktop applications. Once the data is in the other file format, the desktop application (with which users may be very familiar or expert) can manipulate and summarize the data.
ODBC (Open DataBase Connectivity)	Desktop applications that are ODBC-enabled, such as MS Access, can access ACquire reports directly, without going through a view-and-extract sequence. This can increase report production automation significantly.
